Empire Day was established in 1901 just after the death of Queen Victoria to celebrate the British Empire by its children.

It was celebrated in school across the empire and remained a significant event for over 50 Years and still does so in the form of Commonwealth Day, now with a common theme.

Our nation school in Pinner was one such school and the Pinner Local History Society has in its archive photographs of girls taken in the school playground

Regrettably the photos are undated and only three people are noted, E. Pendry as Britannia, teachers Mrs. Moores and Miss Edwards, nee Pooley.
